**Program Summary:** As a student you'll learn how to provide person-centered support for daily living activities to clients in their homes and/or residential care facilities. You'll learn about common diseases, infections, chronic illnesses and disorders found in a residential care setting; techniques to assist clients with self-management and activities like bathing, dressing, hygiene care, diet, exercise, social interactions, and more. You'll learn how to assist in clients taking medications properly and how to assist them in community and social engagement activities. You'll also learn computer skills that will help you manage your life as a caregiver.

**Pre-requisites:** Must be 18 years or older and have basic computer skills. Recommend: ESL level Intermediate-Low and higher. High school diploma *not* required.

**Cost & Fee Waiver:** \$250.00 (for all three courses)

Fee waiver qualifications: To have your fees waived you must be:

- Taking this course for Adult School High School Diploma elective credit. OR
- A current student at any Adult School or Community College in Southern or Middle Alameda County AND legally able to work AND to accept employment within 60 days of completion.

### After Training Employment Opportunities Available in...

- Group Homes with youth ages 5-22 years old
- Adult Residential Care with clients 18-60 years old
- Elder Care Residential homes with clients 61+ years old
- In private homes through Alameda County public agency
- In private homes as an employee of a private agency

**Starting pay range:** \$10.50 - \$15.00/hour

**Shifts:** Full-time, Part-time & on-call. Morning, evening, nights.

**Certification:** 1st Aid / CPR. Satisfies HIPPA requirements.

**Job Placement Assistance:** For job placement, you must pass the coursework at 80% or higher, be legally able to work in the United States and be able to pass a criminal record clearance. Additional fees for fingerprinting will be required
